After learning about solids, you'll understand and remember the following a bit better:

The 3rd perek of Mesechta Shabbos mentions 3 types of stoves: cupach, tanoor, and kira.

Cupach is a cube that holds only one pot. The way to remember this is the both cupach and cube start with a "cu" sound".

Tanoor is a trapezoidal solid, wider on the bottom and tapering to a narrow top, and it holds one pot. Both tanoor and trapezoid start with a "t" sound.

Kira is a rectangular solid that holds two pots, Both kira and rectangle have a "ra" sound.
